his paper assessed the Almajiri System of Education in Norther Western States of Nigeria. The Almajiri education system has posed serious challenge to children's development and form part of the major typical issue in Nigeria and National Security The conventional Almajiri way of life has become a jeopardy to the economic system and National security. It records that the Almajiri system of education in its originality could not have been considered a source of concern until the abused of its practice in modern times; who are now turned into child labourers, street-beggers and juvenile delinquents. The Almajiri today is nothing but a time-bomb waiting for explosion, are left to cater for themselves and are equally abused by their scrounging teachers (Mallams). However, it is noted that factors such as Poverty, Government negligence, Parental glibness, Unemployment, Lak of Western education, increase in population effected by the culture if marrying many wives, e.t.c has contributed to the tremendous increase of the Almajirai and their plight in Northern Nigeria. For instance, out of 13.2 million children of school age, North alone has about 70% of the number. This obnoxious situation which is a sign of educational under-development requires an urgent solution for a better and crime free Nigeria. To do this, Government at all levels should eliminate street begging; and there should be a free and compulsory basic education for every child in Nigeria and emphasis on vocational and entrepreneurial education, Islamic system of education should be modernized and Islamic teachers should be empowered. This is necessary because to continue having a growing number of uneducated children roaming the street will end up spelling doom for the country. This has affected the socio-economic development of the North in particular and Nigeria in general. This study employs Parental Callousness Theory as a Theoretical Framework.
